



Concerned about the safety of a child?


If you are concerned about the well-being of a child or you believe she/he may be at risk of significant harm you can speak to:

If they are not available and you think the child is at risk of significant harm, ring Staffordshire Children's Advice and Support Team on <u>0300 III 8007</u> or the emergency out of office hours number — make sure you have the child's DOB, address, parents' telephone numbers, siblings' details.
